Drop in anytime between 4:00-7:00pm and reconnect with your friends from Los Osos! We inaugurated this event last year, and it was a HUGE SUCCESS! Students from all different eras of our program mingled and reunited and had a great time! All program alumni and booster club folks are invited to attend! Wear your letterman’s jackets, warm-ups, or other Osos gear and come help us celebrate 16 years of excellence! Go Osos!

- **DONATIONS NEEDED** – The band, orchestra and color guard program is in immediate need of donations of the following items. The school budget does not provide for these items. If each student could commit to bring even one item throughout the semester, it would be greatly appreciated, and will help preserve our precious budget money for more urgent issues like instrument repair. **Thanks so much to those who have already donated!**
 - 1) Rolls of 1” wide blue painter’s tape (for marking the Regiment field at 4-step intervals on Tuesday/Friday/Saturday rehearsals).
 - 2) Bottles of “Wright’s” (or similar brand) silver polish for our Regiment Sousaphones, mellophones, and baritones.
 - 3) Large bottles of hand sanitizer (helps keep our hands clean before touching their instruments each day and helps to keep our students from getting ill and missing school and rehearsal).

- **HONOR BAND & ORCHESTRA OPPORTUNITIES** – Participation in an honor bands & orchestras provides a challenging, musically-rewarding opportunity for students and helps them to advance their musical knowledge and understanding beyond simply playing in their own high school groups. Honor group participation also looks great on college and university applications. Honor groups are “extra,” meaning that they are in addition to your first commitment, which is to your own program here at Los Osos. Dr. Andress does grant some schedule exceptions to honor band students when overlaps occur, but as always it is the student’s responsibility to work this out in advance. We encourage *all* of our students to seek out an honor band or orchestra experience this school year. The following opportunities are currently available:
 - **SAN BERNARDINO COUNTY HONOR BAND** – Please visit www.sbcmea.org and click on the “Honor Bands – Basin” tab at the top. Then click on the “High School” tab and read the information there. Please put the \$7.00 audition charge (cash or check made out to LOHS Band) into THE BOX by no later than Friday, October 27, 2017, inside an envelope marked with the student name, instrument(s) and “SB County Honor Band.” Late submissions will not be accepted. Students auditioning on multiple instruments pay \$7.00 *per audition*. If the website is not yet updated for this year, please be patient and continue to check back. Students MAY audition for this ensemble. It does NOT interfere with the LO Festival of Bands, which will be held that Friday evening (after the County rehearsal is over).

- **SCSBOA ALL-SOUTHERN HONOR BANDS, ORCHESTRA, AND JAZZ BAND** – Please visit www.scsboa.org and click on the “Honor Groups” tab for full information. All applications **MUST** be submitted online along with your \$30 application fee payable via credit/debit card. No other payment method will be accepted. Incomplete applications will not be processed. The time-stamped deadline for High School **CONCERT** applications/fees is 11:59 PM on November 3, 2017. Applications/fees will not be accepted or processed after the 11:59 PM timestamp on November 3, 2017 and no audition times will be issued. No walk-in applications or payments will be accepted. Directors will receive a listing of students from their school who wish to audition for verification and audition approval. Deadline for verification to the SCSBOA office will be no later than November 10, 2017.

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TUESDAY, OCTOBER 17, 2017

- **ASSIGNMENT (for all brass, woodwind and string players in all classes)** – Reed/slide/rosin check today for 25 points. Woodwinds will have five (5) good-quality reeds on their stand for inspection. These reeds need to be out of the wrappers and should be rotated each day so that each woodwind student has a minimum of five (5) working reeds at any good time. Brass players will be expected to completely disassemble and reassemble their horns (all slides and valves out and back in) in a reasonable timeframe. This demonstrates that all slides and valves are in good working order and can be manipulated for proper intonation. String players will have rosin and demonstrate that the bow and all strings are in good, playable condition.
- Zero period (6:45am) Concert Band and Wind Ensemble rehearsal at the Band Hall (remember concert instrument please – no marching brass instruments in these rehearsals if possible) & Regiment percussion and color guard rehearsal Grizzly Field, dressed in school clothes and white Dinkles (bring your regular shoes to change into after rehearsal).

- **STUDENT STAFF** – Please set-up Study Hall furniture (4 Cafeteria tables, chairs all around) in the Band Hall today during 2nd lunch so that it is ready for this afternoon. Thank you!
- This evening’s rehearsal schedule is as follows. **Attire for all members of the Regiment during the evening rehearsal will be rally t-shirts and LOHS PE shorts or NAVY BLUE workout-type athletic shorts, with warm-up jacket and pants. - 4:00pm** Master Classes at the Band Hall. Today's master class is for all Regiment students. Section leaders, please remember to report master class attendance (tardies/absences) to the secretaries at the field at 5:30pm. This is very important!
- 5:00pm** Break.
- 5:15pm** Regiment rehearsal at Grizzly Field: full-ensemble stretch, warm-up & tuning and attendance in the west endzone of Grizzly Field, as the football team exits. Put on shakos/plumes, warm-up pants, t-shirts tucked in (jackets later in the evening as it cools off).
- 5:30pm** Visual basics block (stations?) or learn new show choreography.
- Band uniform fittings tonight from 5:30-8:30pm in the Band Hall for those students from Day Creek Intermediate who will be participating with us in the RC Founders' Day Parade.
- 6:30pm** Show cleaning block #1. Student Staff members rotated out of rehearsal to view progress from the top of the pressbox.
- 7:30pm** Show cleaning block #2.
- 8:30pm** Rehearsals end – students dismissed.

- 12:00pm** **CALL TIME** at Grizzly Field – DO NOT BE LATE! – **Attendance will be taken at this time!**
“To be early is to on time to be on time is to be late, and to be late is absolutely unacceptable!”
Full Regiment rehearsal at Grizzly Field, dressed in warm-ups, with PE shorts and Regiment t-shirts underneath and tall **black socks and black Dinkles**. ALL students bring water!!! Hats and sunglasses are advisable for rehearsal.
- 2:00pm (ish)** Rehearsal ends. Load trucks/buses. Students dismissed to meet at Chaffey HS. **Transportation to and from this performance is on your own. Please allow ample time for traffic and for parking. Carpools are suggested.**

- 4:30pm** Call time at Chaffey HS. Meet Dr. A in the parking lot behind the home side stadium bleachers (lot with solar panels). We will walk as a group to our equipment vehicles, which may be parked in a different lot. **BE ON TIME** (early) so that you don't miss us! **Attendance will be taken at this time!** After we walk to the equipment trucks and trailers and put away the instruments and duffel bags, etc. students will be dismissed to enter stadium to purchase food (snack bar) and watch other bands. **PLEASE REMEMBER WHO YOU ARE, AND WHAT YOU REPRESENT!** Pit crew and uniform crew set-up camp. Chaperones enter stadium and monitor and assist students as needed in the snack bar area and the visitor side bleachers.
- 6:00pm** Call time at the trucks/buses to stretch, change into uniform, and assemble instruments and equipment and go directly into full-ensemble visual rehearsal.
- 7:30pm** Music sectionals, full-ensemble music warm-up, tuning, and rehearse show chunks.
- 7:15pm** Depart for entrance gate.
- 7:30pm** **PERFORMANCE!**
- 7:45pm** Performance ends. March from field directly to equipment trucks and buses to change out of uniform and back into warm-ups. Battery and pit percussion work quickly to break down the equipment for the pit crew to load during the awards. All students will be inside the stadium for the RCC performance. The goal is to get the trucks *mostly loaded* before that time. **WE WANT TO NOT BE THE LAST GROUP OUT OF THE PARKING LOT THIS EVENING!**
- 8:15pm** Awards ceremony. Full Regiment sits/stands as a group in the visitor side bleachers.
- 8:45pm** Awards ceremony ends. Transportation to and from this performance is on your own. Students who are waiting for their rides will wait as a group near our equipment vehicles with our chaperones until their transportation has arrived. THURSDAY, NOVEMBER 2, 2017

- Zero Period Students to bring their luggage to school at this time. Students will load trucks and store their luggage on the LOHS theater stage. Travel clothing is navy blue music logo polo shirt, blue jeans and tennis shoes.
- 12:55 PM Directly after 4th period and 1st and 2nd lunches - meet at the LOHS Theater dressed in navy blue Music polo, blue jeans and tennis shoes for travel. Students will be seated in the theater until instructed to pick up their luggage from the stage and move to the band parking lot.
- 1:15 PM – 1:30 PM Load instruments and luggage: All large instruments and staff luggage go beneath bus #1. Small wind instruments go INSIDE of whichever bus the student is riding. Buses 2-5 are strictly for luggage. Students put their luggage under the bus they are riding. Students from bus #1 put their luggage under any other bus. We do not mix instruments and student luggage.
- 1:45 PM (Approx.) Depart from LOHS. Fast food dinner stop at Primm, NV. approximately 4:45 PM. This meal is on your own – it is **NOT** included in the price of the trip. You may bring your own sack dinner as well.
- 9:30 PM (Approx.) Arrive at hotel – Wingate by Wyndham - 780 West State St. Hurricane, UT 84737 (435) 359-9100. Students unload luggage from the busses and check-in to their rooms.
- 10:30 PM Room check. All students are in their own respective rooms, doors are taped.

FRIDAY, NOVEMBER 3, 2017

- 6:00 AM Chaperones wake all rooms and remove door tape. Students get dressed in warm-ups with shirts tucked in and white Dinkles.
- 6:30 – 7:30 AM Breakfast in the hotel lobby (breakfast is included with the hotel accommodations).
- 7:00 AM Adult Pit Crew setting up at Hurricane High stadium parking lot.
- 7:30 AM Call time in hotel parking lot with instruments. Take a ½ mile walk to Hurricane High School stadium.
- 8:00 AM Arrive at Hurricane High School stadium - 345 West Tiger Blvd. Hurricane, UT 84737. Assemble on field with all equipment and instruments for rehearsal.
- 8:00 AM – 11:00 AM Rehearsal. Water will be provided.
- 11:00 AM Students and chaperones on Bus # 5 will board bus to Zion with a boxed lunch. **Students on bus #5 will need to bring tennis shoes and street clothes to the morning rehearsal to change into for the Zion hike.**

HOTEL GUIDELINES

- 1) **Under no circumstances whatsoever are males and females to be socializing in each other's rooms.** While being conscious of not disrupting other hotel guests, students may socialize in the hotel lobby.
- 2) Room checks will be made nightly by the Director and official chaperones. Students are expected to be in their designated rooms at that time. Curfew will be set by the Director, in accordance with the hotel policy.
- 3) Students are to remain inside their rooms until the designated time to wake in the morning. (No roaming the halls at night!)
- 4) Hotel rooming assignments may not be altered. Students are not permitted to switch rooms during a trip unless prior arrangements have been made with the Director.
- 5) Students are responsible for damage and/or losses they cause while on the trip, including any damage to hotel rooms or public facilities.
- 6) Students and chaperones will be billed for any missing items from hotel rooms upon checkout. (This includes towels).

- 7) Students may not leave the hotel unless accompanied by an LOHS chaperone or staff member.
- 8) If any student or chaperone causes undue noise or behavior that warrants other hotel guests to check-out early and request a “refund,” that individual student or chaperone will be responsible for the financial burden of such “early check-outs.”
- 9) Practice COURTESY at all times.
- 10) Students may not use the hotel swimming pool.
- 11) Room phones may not be used to make outgoing and long-distance phone calls.
- 12) Students and chaperones are not permitted to order room service. This situation could vastly complicate the billing process, as the rooms are fully paid- for prior to the trip.

STUDENT PACKING CHECKLIST

Clearly label all personal items with your name.

- 1) Instrument (Including all necessary accessories – valve oil, cork grease, extra reeds, polishing cloth, swabs, etc.)
- 2) Music/drill binders, dot book, etc. as necessary for rehearsal.
- 3) Clean, unwrinkled navy blue music logo polo shirt(s) and jeans.
- 4) Comfortable walking shoes. Students may want to bring an extra pair of shoes in case of wet weather.
- 5) Clean Rally shirt (bring second clean Rally shirt if you want one for rehearsals and one for performance).
- 6) Warm-ups – jacket and pants.
- 7) **Band:** White Dinkles and socks, black Dinkles and black socks, gloves, wristbands, berets, etc. – any item you need for a full uniform performance.
- 8) **Color Guard** – Uniform with all parts and components, gloves, shoes, hair pieces, make up, equipment, etc. – any item you need for a full uniform performance.
- 9) Appropriate street clothes for dinner dance party. School dress code will apply.
- 10) Bathing suit and towel for pool party. Bring a plastic bag for packing damp clothing/shoes.
- 11) Sleepwear, sweats, undergarments, etc. and a **warm jacket**.
- 12) Spending money for **two** fast food meals, additional optional money for snacks, and any souvenirs.
- 13) Music/movie players, phones (chargers and headphones), books, magazines, games, cards and HOMEWORK, for the bus rides - busses may or may not have DVD players. Movies for the bus must be rated PG-13 or lower.
- 14) Snacks for the bus (clean stuff that won't spill, please).

- 15) All necessary toiletries – **including items needed for putting your hair up in your shako!**
- 16) Any necessary medications. Students will be checking all medication (except inhalers) with our nurse chaperone. Asthmatics **MUST BRING INHALERS WITH THEM** and keep it on their person **AT ALL TIMES!**

Students and chaperones are to minimize their packing to one suitcase, one instrument case, and one “carry-on” backpack/purse/bag per person. Please understand that there is a limited amount of storage space on the busses.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- 1) All guidelines regarding student behavior, which are outlined in the Los Osos High School Student Handbook, are in effect for out-of-town and overnight trips.
- 2) Chaffey District “Authorization to Consent to Treatment of Minor” cards will be maintained by the Director in the event of a medical need.
- 3) Chaffey District policies regarding the number of chaperones per student will be observed.
- 4) Students and adult chaperones are expected to participate in all scheduled activities. The Director and chaperones will check to see that participants are present for all activities.
- 5) Students are not permitted to leave the premises at any scheduled activity or group function without being accompanied by an LOHS chaperone or staff member.
- 6) Students and chaperones must be ready for all scheduled departures and activities at the times listed on the official itinerary.
- 7) Dress standards require modest and appropriate attire at all times. School dress code policy is still in effect on out-of-town and overnight trips.
- 8) Drinking of alcoholic beverages, the use of illegal drugs, and the use of tobacco products and electronic cigarettes are strictly prohibited. Any student who violates this policy will be sent home immediately at the expense of his or her parent/guardian (including forfeit of the cost of the trip) and will face disciplinary action that may include but not be limited to removal from the band program. All school policies and consequences regarding this topic are in effect on out-of-town and overnight trips.
- 9) Vulgar language is not acceptable at any time. This applies to students as well as adults.
- 10) Impromptu informational meetings may be called occasionally. Attendance by all students and chaperones is required at these meetings.
