All applications **MUST** be submitted online along with your \$30 application fee payable via credit/debit card. No other payment method will be accepted. Incomplete applications will not be processed. The time-stamped deadline for High School applications/fees is 11:59 PM on November 3, 2017. Applications/fees will not be accepted or processed after the 11:59 PM timestamp on November 3, 2017 and no audition times will be issued. No walk-in applications or payments will be accepted. Directors will receive a listing of students from their school who wish to audition for verification and audition approval. Deadline for verification to the SCSBOA office will be no later than November 10, 2017.

- **TIPS TO BE STRESS FREE** – Rehearsal schedules, performances and other commitments can make for an exceptionally stressful time of year, especially as the weather is cold and immune systems tend to be weaker.
  - 1) **Start the day right.** Try to find a routine – get up a little earlier than you typically do. Eat something before you start your day. It's important to set the tone for the rest of your day.
  - 2) **Relax.** Find moments of calm in our ever-busy lives and schedules is important when it comes to maintaining a balanced lifestyle. These moments can be anything that you find relaxing, such as running, listening to music, reading a book, playing your instruments for pure enjoyment, or just sitting and breathing – we often forget to truly let our bodies and minds relax.

**3) Detox from digital devices.** Managing stress has become more difficult as fear of missing out has become more and more a part of our digital lives. Digital detoxing has become increasingly important as far as stress management is concerned – try turning your phone off for one day a week or a month. You might be surprised at how liberating it feels. As we continue to be more invested and deeply concerned with the online versions of our lives we bring on more stress and a more confused identity. - **AUDITION RESULTS** – Over the course of these past week we have administered over 175 brass and woodwind auditions for placement into our Blue/Gold Concert Bands and Wind Ensemble. Many students spent the time needed to produce a fine, well-presented audition which displayed their talents in a positive way. Some did not. We realize that these auditions are not easy. Really, they are like a job interview; a brief time to put one's self on display in an attempt to put forward the very best qualities of talent that the individual has to offer. Our program has and always will be ABILITY-BASED and not seniority-based. This is because we believe that, like in the big world outside of Los Osos, those who are best equipped to handle a job are often rewarded with that job. In our audition process we balanced two aspects of each student who auditioned: 1) ability 2) character & work ethic. It is natural that a certain amount of competition exists. All students in our program want to do their best and to earn the “first chair” placement in the top band. We value and respect all students who participate in this activity. It requires long hours of dedicated, focused work, and this is not for everyone. Unfortunately, there are only so many first-chair positions available. Please know that ALL students will contribute largely to the success of that ensemble. Feelings of disappointment are natural following the audition process for those who did not achieve as high a placement as they had desired. This is OKAY. Auditions are important because, like job interviews, the only way to get better at them is to continue to do them and to learn from them and to gain experience with how to navigate them successfully. Those students who did not earn the placement that they had hoped for should think things over for a few days (reflect on the experience) then see Dr. A during lunch or after school, and ask for some feedback on how to improve from this point forward. Remember, this is a LEARNING process and we are always happy to give feedback and guidance. We know that all of our students will demonstrate their good character by coping with their success or disappointment in a mature, professional way. We know that our students understand that the success of the PROGRAM involves and depends upon all of us. We have enjoyed an outstanding start to this school year. Now, let's move **Onward!**

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**MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 18, 2017 – Happy Birthday to Former Regiment Drum Major Christina Rios! (Class of 2006) & Happy Birthday to the late and great Dr. Jeffrey Tower, Our Former Jazz Instructor!**

- Zero period (6:45am) Regiment rehearsal at Grizzly Field, dressed in school clothes and white Dinkles (bring your regular shoes to change into after rehearsal).
  - **STUDENT STAFF** – Please bring in the water cart, marimbas and music stands, lock the bins and ensure that the Band Hall is locked down and in tip-top shape today by the end of 2<sup>nd</sup> lunch, thank you!
  - The Band Hall will be open today until 1:00pm. Please plan accordingly. Students, please do not ask another teacher, security guard, or custodian to open the room for you after it has been locked. This creates a security and liability issue for the school. Please know that the room is not accessible today after 1:00pm and please plan ahead.
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**TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 19, 2017 – Happy Birthday to Former Regiment Drum Major Carolina Cooney! (Class of 2007)**

- Zero period (6:45am) Concert Band and Wind Ensemble rehearsal at the Band Hall (remember concert instrument please – no marching brass instruments in these rehearsals) & Regiment percussion and color guard rehearsal Grizzly Field, dressed in school clothes and white Dinkles (bring your regular shoes to change into after rehearsal).
- **ASSIGNMENT (for all brass, woodwind and string players in all classes)** – Reed/slide/rosin check today for 25 points. Woodwinds will have five (5) good-quality reeds on their stand for inspection. These reeds need to be out of the wrappers and should be rotated each day so that each woodwind student has a minimum of five (5) working reeds at any good time. Brass players will be expected to completely disassemble and reassemble their horns (all slides and valves out and back in) in a reasonable timeframe. This demonstrates that all slides and valves are in good working order and can be manipulated for proper intonation. String players will have rosin and demonstrate that the bow and all strings are in good, playable condition.
- **SYMPHONIC BAND CHAIR CHALLENGE** – Spencer Raymond vs. Trenton Hickman (trumpet).
- **STUDENT STAFF** – Please set-up Study Hall furniture (4 Cafeteria tables, chairs all around) in the Band Hall today during 2<sup>nd</sup> lunch so that it is ready for this afternoon. Thank you!
- This evening's rehearsal schedule is as follows. **Attire for all members of the Regiment during the evening rehearsal will be rally t-shirts and LOHS PE shorts or NAVY BLUE workout-type athletic shorts, with warm-up jacket and pants. Students will wear the**

**white marching band shoes (“Dinkles”). Please remember hats, sunblock, sunglasses, and a big bottle of water. Students dressed inappropriately will be sent home.**

**REGIMENT REHEARSAL:**

- 2:55pm** Dinner break. Bring a sack lunch, parents drop something off, or leave campus. Please be on time getting back. **An optional-but-suggested study hall will be held during this hour** inside the Band Hall. This time is designed for students to do their homework and the room is kept quiet during that time. Students may eat quietly while they do their homework, however the Band Hall must be left clean at the end of this time. **Edward Lee** will monitor today’s study hall and keep the room quiet and on-task.
- 4:00pm** Master Classes at the Band Hall. Today’s master class is for all band students! Flutes = C20 (Rannis), Returning member clarinets and all bass clarinets = C62 (DeChenne), Rookie clarinets = C66 (McFadden), Saxes = C63 (Audet), Trombones = C71 (Van Stryland), F horns = C75 (Bell-Nixon). All other brass = Theatre Stage or Band Hall (if drama is on stage).
- 5:00pm** Break.
- 5:15pm** Regiment rehearsal at Grizzly Field: full-ensemble stretch, warm-up & tuning and attendance in the west endzone of Grizzly Field, as the football team exits.
- 5:30pm** Visual basics block stations.
- 6:30pm** Learn new drill.
- 7:30pm** Clean old drill & run large chunks. Student Staff members rotated out of rehearsal to view progress from the top of the pressbox.
- 8:30pm** Rehearsals end – students dismissed.
- 8:45pm** **PARENT/GUARDIANS SHOULD BE HERE AT THIS TIME TO PICK-UP THEIR STUDENTS.**
- 9:00pm** Band Hall lights-off and doors locked. All students must be pick-up or driving away from campus prior to this time. Please plan accordingly. **ALL CHILDREN LEFT UNATTENDED WILL BE SOLD TO THE CIRCUS.**
