- **RANCHO CUCAMONGA COMMUNITY BAND** – The city of Rancho Cucamonga Community Services Department invites you to join the 10th Annual “Rancho Cucamonga Community Band,” conducted by Don Jaramillo and Sam Andress. Comprised of brass, woodwind, and percussion, this concert band is open to those with at least three years of playing experience. - **ASSIGNMENT (for all brass, woodwind and string players in all classes)** – Reed/slide/rosin check today for 25 points. Woodwinds will have five (5) good-quality reeds on their stand for inspection. These reeds need to be out of the wrappers and should be rotated each day so that each woodwind student has a minimum of five (5) working reeds at any good time. Brass players will be expected to completely disassemble and reassemble their horns (all slides and valves out and back in) in a reasonable timeframe. This demonstrates that all slides and valves are in good working order and can be manipulated for proper intonation. String players will have rosin and demonstrate that the bow and all strings are in good, playable condition.

5:00pm Call Time at the LOHS Band Hall - **DO NOT BE LATE!** – **Attendance will be taken at this time!** *“To be early is to be on time, to be on time is to be late, and to be late is absolutely unacceptable!”*

** On-campus parking on this evening will be a challenge. Several thousand people will be on campus tonight. Please arrange to carpool or be dropped-off if possible. Please plan ahead, and allow for parking issues so that you are not late to call time. This is very important!*

5:00pm Call Time at the Band Hall, fully-dressed in our official concert attire.

5:30pm Process to stadium.

6:00pm Begin playing pre-ceremony music on the field.

6:30pm Ceremony begins – “Pomp & Circumstance.”

8:30pm Ceremony concludes. Band/Orchestra plays music as graduates and parents mingle on the field and take pictures.

8:45pm Performance finishes. ALL students help return instruments and equipment to the Band Hall and put things away.

POST-GRADUATION JOB ASSIGNMENTS ARE AS FOLLOWS: Students are dismissed to leave from this FINAL EXAM, following completion of their part of the list!

DRUM MAJORS: BE THE KEEPER OF THE KEYS. Supervise everything, lock-up everything, check-out with Dr. A when the entire project is finished. Station yourselves at the Band Hall cart computer and supervise the check-in of instruments from non-returning band and orchestra students. Instruments should be cleared from the computer first, then lined-up neatly in front of the Band Hall whiteboard. Please ensure that we have appropriate walkways to get through, etc. Generally, oversee that the band and orchestra students are completing the assignments listed below.

LIBRARIANS: Make sure the library is CLEAN, including the floor, table areas, and on top of the file cabinets. All originals should be filed away, and the copier and computer should be turned-off. Lights off and door locked.

OB/BSN: Walk through the instrument storage room, put lost items into the lost and found, and throw away trash. Check the sink for trash, and empty lockers without doors.

FL: Music stands returned to the racks and put back in their proper place in the Band Hall.

CL/BCL/SAXES: Rack all chairs and leave racks neatly along the east side of the stadium track, out of the way.

TUBA: LOHS conductor's podium and music stand placed on the pit cart to be returned to their proper place in the Band Hall. Meet the pit cart down at the Band Hall when Doc gets it there and make sure EVERYTHING on the cart is put away.

HRN: Assist Dr. A with tearing down the sound system. Listen carefully to instructions on this!

TPT/TBN/BTN: Band Hall maintenance. Put things where they go, vacuum the Band Hall, Music Library & Ensemble Room (vacuums located in the library).

PCN: Move ALL percussion equipment back into the Band Hall, and put it away completely. All mallet instruments, chimes, and bass drum should be covered. All small toys should be put away completely in the percussion cabinet, with the doors closed.

9:00pm Non-returning band/orchestra students check-in their instruments and clean-out their lockers at the Band Hall with the Drum Majors prior to leaving. Non-returned instruments/equipment or trash/items left in the instrument lockers will result in a hold being placed on the student's account at the LOHS Student Store. Please take care of this important business!

WHAT TO BRING:

- 1) Instrument - all necessary drums, sticks, mallets, cables, etc.
- 2) Music (three-hole punched or sheet-protected in a three-ring binder, neatly). NO LOOSE PAPER.
- 3) Bottle of water (no breaks during the ceremony – we are on the field the whole time).

CONCERT ATTIRE: We will be wearing our official concert attire for this performance.
NO SUBSTITUTIONS, PLEASE! STUDENTS DRESSED INAPPROPRIATELY WILL BE SENT HOME.
