- **LOS OSOS REGIMENT UNIFORM INFORMATION**

Dear Los Osos Regiment Parents/Guardians and Students,

Please take a moment to read this letter, for it outlines the cleaning and alteration procedures for our band uniforms. Each student is responsible for the care of their assigned uniform, including dry cleaning and alterations. **The uniform remains the sole property of the Los Osos Regiment**, and will remain in the band hall for the duration of the marching season. It will not be kept at the student’s home at any time.

Hemming must be done before the uniform is cleaned. Vineyard Marketplace Cleaners will do alterations, as well as dry cleaning. If you chose to hem the uniform, please **DO NOT CUT OFF ANY MATERIAL. USE A BIND STITCH ONLY.** All hemming must be completed prior to dry cleaning and pressing. If any material is cut, the student will be held responsible for the replacement costs of the uniform. These uniforms will be reused by other students for years to come. If uniforms are damaged in any way, **any and all costs required to repair or replace the uniform will be the student’s responsibility.**

Please deliver uniform to Vineyard Marketplace Cleaners for dry cleaning and alterations *no later than Tuesday, August 1, 2017. Please do not take the uniform to any other location for cleaning or alterations. We have had a wonderful working relationship with Vineyard Marketplace Cleaners for the last several years.* They are kind enough to deliver all of the uniforms directly to Los Osos after they are cleaned, and/or altered.

Vineyard Marketplace Cleaners is located in the Albertsons shopping center, at Milliken and Kenyon, just below the 210 freeway. *Please be certain your receipt indicates both last and first name of your student. *Payment for services is to be made when you deliver the uniform to Vineyard Marketplace Cleaners.

A name tag will be placed on both the jacket and the overall pants during uniform fittings. **Please do not remove the name tags.** The labels help us keep track of the uniforms, and who they are assigned to, when Vineyard Marketplace delivers the back to Los Osos. 😊

- **TIPS TO BE STRESS FREE** – Rehearsal schedules, performances and other commitments can make for an exceptionally stressful time of year, especially as the weather is cold and immune systems tend to be weaker.

1) Start the day right. Try to find a routine – get up a little earlier than you typically do. Eat something before you start your day. It’s important to set the tone for the rest of your day.

2) Relax. Find moments of calm in our ever-busy lives and schedules is important when it comes to maintaining a balanced lifestyle. These moments can be anything that you find relaxing, such as running, listening to music, reading a book, playing your instruments for pure enjoyment, or just sitting and breathing – we often forget to truly let our bodies and minds relax.

3) Detox from digital devices. Managing stress has become more difficult as fear of missing out has become more and more a part of our digital lives. Digital detoxing has become increasingly important as far as stress management is concerned – try turning your phone off for one day a week or a month. Also, eliminate digital light in the wee hours of the night and reserve your bed for only sleep.

All in all, incorporating even just a few of these suggestions into your new health routine will have you feeling a little more at ease and stress-free. When in doubt, just take a few moments for yourself and/or a few deep calming breaths. It’s truly amazing what a few breaths with intention can do.

- **ZERO PERIOD PARKING LOT** – Parents and students, as a reminder please be courteous with the flow of traffic in the mornings prior to zero period. With 240 students enrolled in that early class and all working hard to be on time it is important that all cars keep moving consistently forward after dropping off their student. MONDAY, AUGUST 14, 2017

- Zero period (6:45am) Regiment rehearsal at Grizzly Field, dressed in school clothes and white Dinkles (bring your regular shoes to change into after rehearsal).

- **STUDENT STAFF** – Please bring in the water cart, lock the bins and ensure that the Band Hall is locked down and in tip-top shape today by the end of 2nd lunch, thank you!
 - The Band Hall will be open today until 1:00pm. Please plan accordingly. Students, please do not ask another teacher, security guard, or custodian to open the room for you after it has been locked. This creates a security and liability issue for the school. Please know that the room is not accessible today after 1:00pm and please plan ahead.
 - **ASSIGNMENT (for all Regiment Students)** – Visit the “News & Notes” section of School Loop. On the page where the *Weekly* is posted, there also appears our Regiment drill packet, posted as a PDF, and a video of the drill. Download and print-out the newest drill pages, as well as any that you are missing from your folder, and have them 3-hole punched and placed into your music folder for tomorrow’s rehearsal. NOTE – The drill may not be posted there until Monday afternoon. If you go there and it’s not posted, check back! Questions? Please consult your section leader. Student Staff members, please consider printing a few extra packets for folks in your sections who may have technology issues. THANKS!
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TUESDAY, AUGUST 15, 2017

- Zero period (6:45am) Regiment rehearsal at Grizzly Field, dressed in school clothes and white Dinkles (bring your regular shoes to change into after rehearsal).
- **ASSIGNMENT (for all brass, woodwind and string players in all classes)** – Reed/slide/rosin check today for 25 points. Woodwinds will have five (5) good-quality reeds on their stand for inspection. These reeds need to be out of the wrappers and should be rotated each day so that each woodwind student has a minimum of five (5) working reeds at any good time. Brass players will be expected to completely disassemble and reassemble their horns (all slides and valves out and back in) in a reasonable timeframe. This demonstrates that all slides and valves are in good working order and can be manipulated for proper intonation. String players will have rosin and demonstrate that the bow and all strings are in good, playable condition.
- **“TEEN TRUTH” ASSEMBLY** – Los Osos HS will be hosting our annual Teen Truth Assembly today during 2nd period for our freshmen and any students new to our district. Freshmen will report directly to the Theatre right after 1st period for the assembly. Attendance will be managed through the guidance office. The assembly is slated to start at 9:09am and will last the entire class period.
- **SYMPHONIC BAND CHAIR CHALLENGE** – Kade Saxon vs. Dylan Collins (trumpet).
- **STUDENT STAFF** – Please set-up Study Hall furniture (4 Cafeteria tables, chairs all around) in the Band Hall today during 2nd lunch so that it is ready for this afternoon. Thank you!

- This evening’s rehearsal schedule is as follows. Attire for all members of the Regiment during the evening rehearsal will be rally t-shirts and LOHS PE shorts or NAVY BLUE workout-type athletic shorts. Students will wear the white marching band shoes (“Dinkles”). Please remember hats, sunblock, sunglasses, and a big bottle of water. Students dressed inappropriately will be sent home.

REGIMENT REHEARSAL:

- 2:55pm** Dinner break. Bring a sack lunch, parents drop something off, or leave campus. Please be on time getting back. **An optional-but-suggested study hall will be held during this hour** inside the Band Hall. This time is designed for students to do their homework and the room is kept quiet during that time. Students may eat quietly while they do their homework, however the Band Hall must be left clean at the end of this time. **Zylah Arevalo** will monitor today’s study hall and keep the room quiet and on-task.

- 5:15pm** Full-ensemble stretch in the west end zone of Grizzly Field as the football team exits.
- 5:30pm** Full-ensemble rehearsal at Grizzly Field.
- 8:30pm** Rehearsals end – students dismissed.
- 8:45pm** **PARENT/GUARDIANS SHOULD BE HERE AT THIS TIME TO PICK-UP THEIR STUDENTS.**
- 9:00pm** Band Hall lights-off and doors locked. All students must be pick-up or driving away from campus prior to this time. Please plan accordingly. **ALL CHILDREN LEFT UNATTENDED WILL BE SOLD TO THE CIRCUS.**

WEDNESDAY, AUGUST 16, 2017

- No zero period rehearsals this morning. This is an excellent time for our students to schedule before-school make-up tests or tutoring sessions with their teachers. As a reminder, missing one class to make up work for another class is against school policy. Please schedule make-ups and tutoring so that they do not interfere with our zero period rehearsals.
